It has been a busy week at Capel, as well as lots of developments outside of school. We are, as you might expect, very mindful of the local developments in terms of Covid-19 restrictions. We are constantly reviewing our own Risk Assessment and heeding to local rules, as they apply to us. Not all of the restrictions apply in school for obvious reasons, but our stringent hand washing and restrictions on activities remain firmly in place.

It is very unlikely, but should the school go into lockdown and we need to resort to home learning again, we have a more robust system in place now. Through Microsoft Teams, we will be able to deliver improved online learning, feedback and support. We will be able to identify those not accessing the learning much more quickly, and therefore offer help where it is needed. We are planning on using this system for all homework next term. The children in Years 1-6 will be given a link to follow, their own log in details and password, to enable them to complete the work. We are aiming to reduce the amount of materials going to and from school, as well as giving everyone a chance to get used to the new system before it may be needed for wider purposes. Some of you may already be familiar with Teams as an online platform, but we will be showing the children how to use it in class and teachers will offer support via Dojo too. I am sure there may be a few teething problems, but please don't hesitate to contact your class teacher and we will do our best to rectify them quickly.
