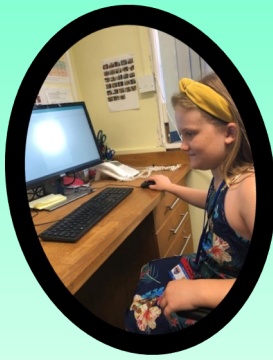


Special Edition Newsletter

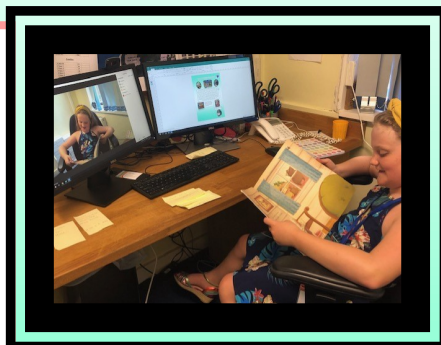
