

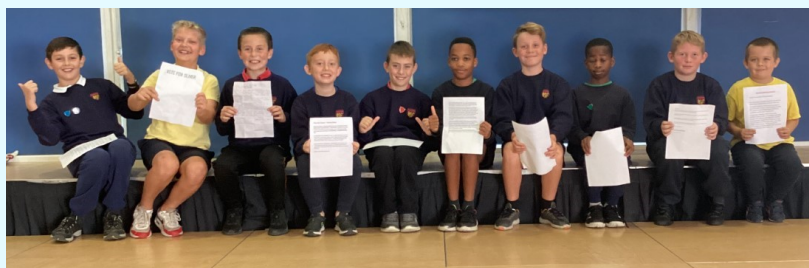


Head boy and Head Girl

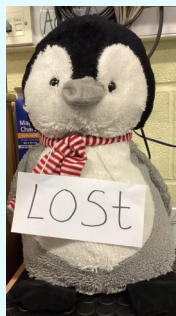
Term 2 ends

This Monday, Year 6 went to Tenterden Railway. We all dressed up in our 1940s garb and experienced life as it was in the Second World War. We went on a steam train, being evacuated to Wales! There we met our billeting families, who chose many of us to go stay with them - we had farmers, mothers, and even a policeman!

On the train, we met Pamela, an evacuee from 1939, who explained her personal experience of being evacuated - and not being chosen by a billeting family!

Back at Tenterden, we saw the real carriages that the evacuees would have travelled in. We had a talk about the types of food we would have eaten - including mash potato and chocolate spread! Then we met Viv the Spiv - he was an interesting fella! He taught us about the black market in WW2, and his chocolate was very tempting.

All in all, we had an amazing day!
