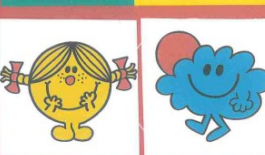

Our latest Enrichment Day has focused on Maths, with a particular exploration on everyday maths and noticing how it is all around us. We looked at patterns, numbers and shapes in detail. We were helped throughout the day by Barney from World of Maths, who enthused all the children with an assembly, and then worked with groups of classes to explore different concepts. Barney amazed the children with wondrous ways of investigating capacity, patterns, nets of shapes with enormous balloons and even a quick way to add all the numbers from 1 to 10, then 1 to 100!

Back in their classes, the children carried on using maths in lots of different ways. They were measuring, creating board games, designing number bond posters and proving mathematical statements together. There were fantastic examples of 'lightbulb' moments, developing vocabulary and strengthening our problem solving muscles.
